INTRO

WHAT'S UP, WAREHOUSE YTH!

WE WANT SIGNS BEFORE WE TAKE A STEP, AND WE WANT IMMEDIATE ANSWERS SO WE DON'T HAVE TO LIVE WITH ANY QUESTIONS. BUT THAT'S NOT LEGIT FAITH; THAT'S LITTLE FAITH, AND GOD WANTS MORE FOR YOU!

THE GOOD NEWS IS, YOU CAN HAVE A FAITH THAT SUSTAINS THROUGH A STORM AND STAYS STRONG EVEN WHEN IT FEELS LIKE YOU'VE BEEN GHOSTED BY GOD. KNOW THIS, GOD WILL NEVER LEAVE YOU, AND HE ALWAYS HAS A PLAN! LET HIM BE WHAT MOVES YOU!

1. **Ice-breaker:** If you could be listed in a Hall of Fame, what would it be for?
2. When you think of the many different characters in the Bible that exhibited GREAT FAITH who comes to mind? Who stands out? What about them or their story makes you think they had GREAT FAITH?
3. Read Hebrews 11. Do any of the characters in this chapter match your pick from question #2 ? (Talk About It)
4. Read Hebrews 11:6. Why do you think God is pleased when we have faith?
5. How would you describe GREAT FAITH?

6. Where in your life have you let your emotions take more control than your faith?
7. Read the story of Shadrach, Meshach, & Abednego in Daniel 3 and then talk about what stands out to you. How do you think you would respond if put in that situation?
8. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had "even if" faith. Even if God didn't do what they hoped, they wouldn't stop worshiping Him. What might "even if" faith look like in your own life?

This week, write down Hebrews 11:6 and keep it somewhere you'll see it regularly.

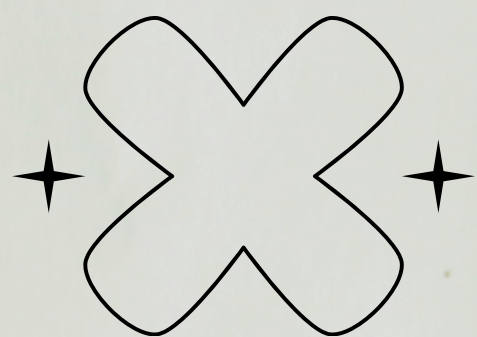
Also make sure to open up your bible this week and read some of the great stories of faith!

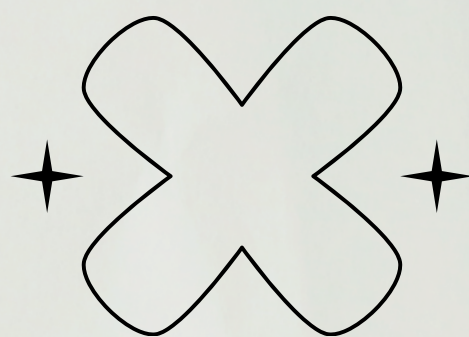

WEEK TWO



LET'S TALK THIS OUT

1. **Ice-breaker:** What's the last thing that made you say, "Wow!" — something that really shocked you? (e.g., a surprise ending to a movie or show, something a friend or celebrity did, something you saw on IG, etc.)

2. Give an example of when God did something in your life that made you say WOW? (has He answered a prayer you've prayed or have you witnessed Him at work in your life in some way .. etc)

3. Read Luke 7:1-10. Jesus marveled at the Roman officer's faith (verse 9), and what Jesus marvels at, we should meditate on. Why do you think the Roman officer's faith surprised Jesus? (Talk About It)

➔ 4. Jesus said the Roman officer had "the greatest faith in Israel." What do you think Jesus would say of your faith right now? Be honest about where you really are.

TALK ABOUT IT

5. What are you believing God for? What would it mean to you for God to answer your prayer today? Would you be ready?

6. Have you ever been afraid to face something? What was it?

7. How can our emotions sometimes go into a battle with our faith? What are some tools you use to distinguish your faith over your emotions?

EXERCISE

We can't predict our future, but we can prepare our faith for it. This week start to prepare your faith now so it can make Jesus say, "Wow!" later? (take the time this week to memorize scripture, pray bigger and bolder prayers, surround yourself with others who have great faith, obey God when you feel Him nudging you to do something, etc.)

LET'S TALK THIS OUT

1. **Ice-breaker:** How long is too long to wait to respond to a text or DM? At what point do you start to wonder if you've been ghosted?
2. Have you ever begged for something and had to wait a long time to get it? What was it?
3. Read Mark 5:24-34 (Talk About It)

4. How do you think you would've felt facing some form of struggle for twelve years straight?
5. Why do you think the woman pushed through the crowd? Have you ever felt like God doesn't see you? (if yes) What do you think made you feel this way?
6. The woman knew her help didn't come from the doctors, they had already tried and failed her. Give an example of something you have went to the world or to people for to fix. What happened?
7. What does it mean when the bible says not to lean on our own understanding? How are you at trusting God when you dont understand your circumstance?
8. What has impacted you the most during our Fueled by Faith study?

This week, write down a promise to help you remember God's got you in the middle of the storm.

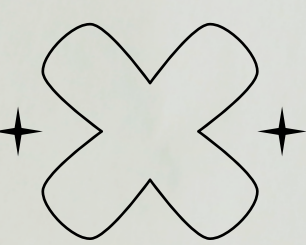
(Need a place to start? We suggest checking out Isaiah 41:10, Isaiah 26:3, John 16:33, and Psalms 37:23-24.)

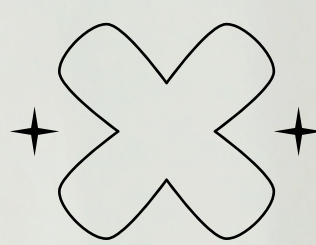

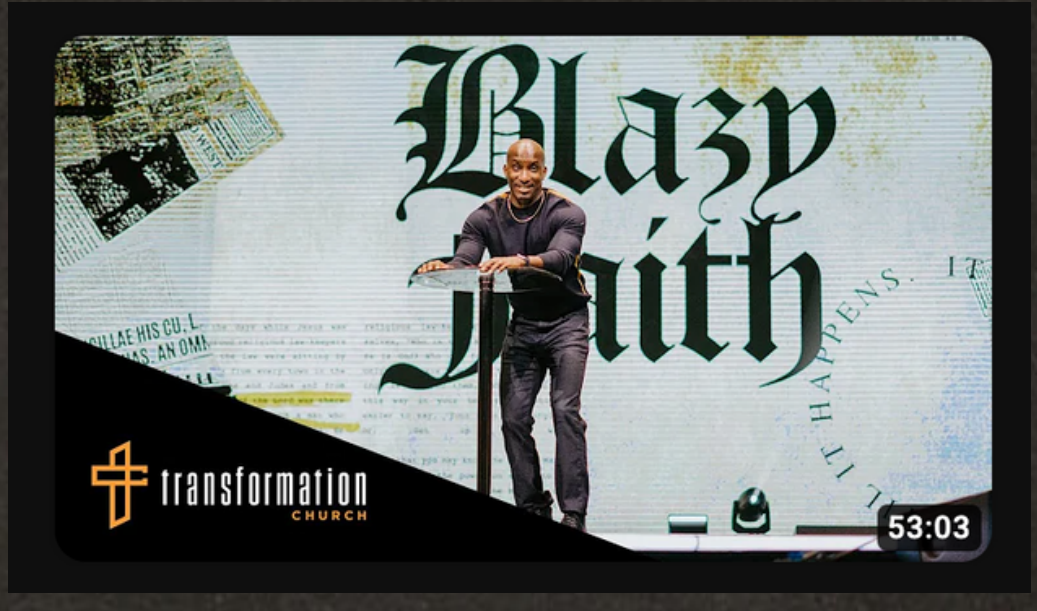
